Facts on dental care for children Young children's teeth are usually smaller, and their gums, jaw and mouth bones are thinner than those of older children's teeth are not yet fully developed, so they often get cavities, lose baby teeth and have other problems. Young children's dental care should be scheduled every 6 to 12 months. Young children need to see a dentist before they are one year old, they can expect a healthy mouth. If your child does not see a dentist by age 3 or 4, he or she may not see a dentist before it's too late. Teeth that remain untreated or improperly treated can turn into painful and costly problems. Even if your child's teeth are healthy, any of these other problems may require treatment: Tooth decay: Children should be seen for their first dental visit by 6 months of age. We can then check the baby's teeth, clean the baby's teeth with a special liquid, treat tooth decay, remove baby teeth and schedule future dental visits. Gum disease: If your child's gum tissue healthy by checking her gums often and cleaning them at every visit. Early loss of baby teeth: Deciduous (baby) teeth start to erupt from the gums between ages 6 and 9 months, and the first molars erupt between ages 12 and 15 months.
